Directions

General Directions to the Conference Center including a map can be found on the Conference Center website above.

From the South (San Jose): Take Highway 101 north to the South Airport Boulevard exit, which is in fact 1 mile north of the San Francisco Airport. Drive straight across the intersection and directly into the Holiday Inn parking lot. The South San Francisco Conference Center is located on the left.

From the North (San Francisco): Take Highway 101 south to the South Airport Boulevard exit. Stay to your right and go east back under the freeway. Take a right at the Hungry Hunter Restaurant, onto South Airport Boulevard. Turn left into the Ramada Inn. The South San Francisco Conference Center is to your right.

From Marin County: Take the Golden Gate Bridge to 19th Avenue and continue on to Highway 280. Take Highway 380 east, to Highway 101 North (towards San Francisco), and exit at South Airport Boulevard (off Highway 101). Drive straight across the intersection and directly into the Holiday Inn parking lot. The South San Francisco Conference Center is on the left.

Public Transport: From the North, the 292 bus line runs every 30 minutes from the Embarcadero Bart station, at First and Mission. Exit at the Shell station on South Airport Boulevard. The South San Francisco Conference Center is across the street. From the South, catch the 292 bus line northbound. Exit at the Holiday Inn on South Airport Blvd. The South San Francisco Conference Center is next door.

BART (650-992-2278) (www.bart.gov) Shuttle service is provided from the local BART station Monday – Friday in the mornings and afternoons.
